All participants are required to participate in the Style Show. We would like you to write the scripts for your outfit. Each participant should write the script to spotlight their outfit. Please bring props to highlight your outfit. For example: a school outfit could have books or an apple for the teacher or a sports outfit could be accessorized with a basketball or a picnic basket. The goal is to help tell a story that puts the spotlight on you. Your narration cards could mention the occasion and help expand on your personal story. Props are not to be used during judging, use them for the style show.

All scripts must be completed when you arrive, please give your script to the person registering. The script should fit on one 3 x 5 card. You may use the back side. Use the information sheet and sample script to help you. If you have any questions, you can call Heather at the St. Croix UW-Extension office (715-531-1938).

Remember to bring your outfit, a 3 x 5 recipe card with your script, and props you need to the Style Revue.
