With the 2018 Dunn County Fair theme being, "Red, White, Blue and YOU", along the 50th Anniversary of the premier of Mister Rogers' Neighborhood, this years food revue will focus on the foods of a neighborhood block party. Your dish could be something traditional in your family, a recipe you learned from a neighbor or something that you discovered through 4-H. Be creative and be ready to explain how your dish is related to this years theme.

Youth will prepare a food item related to the theme and discuss their project with the judge. The judge often shares information with the participant that may help them in future food projects. To help prepare for the event, participants can download a Food Preparation Guide from the UWEX Website. Older members will be judged first, so younger members are encouraged to come to watch and learn.
