Costs: The total cost is approximately \$250.

Winter Camp

Eau Claire, WI | Winter Months

Especially for young adults to build leadership skills and practice teamwork. Camp at Beaver Creek Reserve and experience nature in the beautiful winter season. Potential activities include learning about different native animals, Animal Tracking, Cross Country Skiing, Geocaching, Nature Hikes, and Snowshoeing.

Qualifications:

- ✓ Be in 6th -8th grade at time of camp.

Costs: The total cost is approximately \$40.

STEM Camp

Eau Claire, WI | October

Great camp for members that enjoy science or want to learn more. In this camp, members will get hands on experience on two different kinds of robotics, science in agriculture, and so much more! Registration fee includes lunch, T-shirt, and Supplies

Qualifications:

✓ Be in 3rd -5th grade at time of camp.

Costs: The total cost is approximately \$35.

American Spirit – East

Eastern U.S. | June

This trip is a leadership program that fosters exploration and discovery in 4-H youth by experiencing the American history first hand by seeing historical locations in America's East. Students will record their experience, thoughts, and opinions throughout their journey via a Blog with family and friends, detailing their eye-witness account of America's East.

Qualifications:

✓ Be in 8-10th grade at time of trip.

✓ Be selected at the county level.

Cost: Total cost is approximately \$1,350.

American Spirit – West

Western U.S. | June

This ten-day trip, where members will travel through America's historical and infamous Wild West. This program partners with the National Park Service featuring several national parks stops along the way. The activities vary from ranger-led education programs to service learning projects, and of course includes all the fun camping and hiking. Participants in this program will also document their hands on experience via online media.

Qualifications:

✓ Be in 9-12th grade at time of trip

✓ Be selected at the county level

Costs: The total cost is approximately \$1,225.

Citizenship Washington Focus

Washington D.C. | June/July

Members will have the opportunity to explore destinations such as The Capitol, Mount Vernon, Arlington National Cemetery, the Smithsonian museum. 4-H members from across the country participate in this historically grounded excursion and have said they enjoyed the motivational speakers, educational workshops, and behind-the-scenes look at our nation's capital.

Qualifications:

✓ 10th-12th grade at time of selection;

Minimum age 15 during trip.

✓ Be selected at the county level

Costs: The total cost is approximately \$1,400.



Space Camp

Huntsville, AL | April

This is a fun-filled weekend at the U.S. Space & Rocket Center where participants complete a simulated Space Shuttle mission, experience training simulators, tour the U.S. Space & Rocket Center, and learn about becoming an astronaut.

Space Camp trainees also climb the tallest mountain on the red planet with the Mars Climbing Wall, experience four times the gravity of Earth with the liftoff force of the Space Shot™ simulator, and get an astronaut's view of Earth in the IMAX® Spacedome Theater.

Qualifications:

✓ Be in 6th -8th grade at time of trip. Maximum age 15 at time of trip.

✓ Carry county approval through time of trip

Costs: The total cost is approximately \$625.

National 4-H Congress

Atlanta, GA | November

National 4-H Congress is the flagship event of the 4-H program. The schedule includes workshops designed to develop leadership skills, plenary Sessions with outstanding speakers and entertainers, a Service Learning Experience during which you will participate in hands-on service projects, as well as, tours and recreational opportunities throughout the Atlanta area.

Qualifications:

✓ Be in 10th-12th grade at time of selection.

Maximum age 18 during trip.

Costs: The total cost is approximately \$1,200.

The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation may sponsor a portion of the cost.
