- 4. An application must be accompanied by:
  - a. an essay, (between 200 and 300 words), entitled, "Why I Want to Study in the Field I Have Chosen"
  - b. Three letters of recommendation
    - i. One from a teacher of their choice
    - ii. Two from any professional, business, or responsible citizen of their community
- 5. The application and letters of recommendation should be sent to the Dunn County Family Living Agent by <u>Friday, March 29, 2019</u>.
- 6. The Dunn County Association for Home & Community Education Scholarship Committee will meet and select one applicant to receive the award prior to the date when local awards are presented.
- 7. The Scholarship will be paid in two installments. The first installment will be paid by the Dunn County HCE Treasurer when she is notified that the recipient has successfully completed the first semester. When the recipient has successfully completed the second semester, the second and final installment will be paid. Responsibility for such notification rests with the recipient. Recipient must be enrolled to attend with the University of Wisconsin-Stout, Menomonie, or the Chippewa Valley Technical College-Menomonie.
