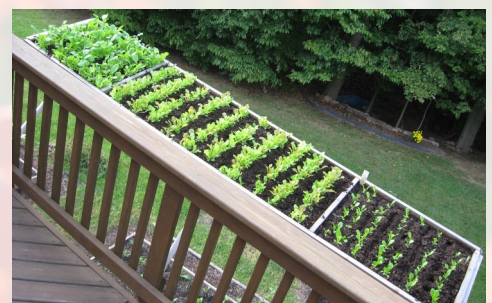


Spring Begins!
